Many global structures and institutions are shaped by **colonial continuities**. On the way to a “**Global We**” as a prerequisite for the necessary **global transformation**, we must face this debate with our partners from the Global South, set their perspective against our often Eurocentric approaches and perspectives, take them into account with the appropriate respect and together take steps of change.

This workshop will take up important aspects of this debate and discuss them using **key questions and concrete examples** such as:

- Which concrete examples for **postcolonial structures & behaviours** can we still identify?
- How do we **include positions and perspectives** from the Global South in our search for transformative solutions?
- How can we avoid falling back into these **structural continuities** again and again?
- Can a **multi-perspective approach** be institutionalized to prevent exactly that?
